INTRODUCTION



Did you know it has been 35 years since a Shelby County resident held the title of Mrs. Ohio America? This pageant provides women with a unique opportunity to promote their platforms across Ohio at a higher level of visibility. For me, this is especially important because my charitable cause is deeply meaningful to so many people, Morgan's Place Cemetery.

Unfortunately, many women experience miscarriage or early infant loss at some point, but across the state, there is a lack of access to miscarriage kits, funding for burials, and grief support for parents, grandparents, siblings, and even the medical personnel who serve grieving families. My husband Nathan and I experienced these gaps in resources firsthand. We have nine living children, but we have also suffered the loss of two babies named Morgan and Marion. In November 2022, after the heartbreaking trials of pregnancy loss, we opened **Morgan's Place Cemetery** to serve and assist other families facing early infant loss. This Shelby County cemetery is located on our 200-year-old family farm.



Shelby County has always been our home. Nathan is a 7th-generation farmer, and I have worked in the school system as an Occupational Therapy Practitioner for over 20 years. I now also serve as the Executive Director of Morgan's Place Cemetery. Since its opening two years ago, we have been honored to support over 200 families by providing caskets, funerals, grave markers, burial gowns, miscarriage kits, keepsakes, and grief support—all at no cost to families.
